13. SWIMMING POOL:

(E) Food and non-alcoholic drink is allowed in the pool area. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area at any time. No glass bottles or glassware is allowed at any time. All residents and their guests are required to clean up any garbage they bring into the pool area. This change on allowing food in the pool area is on a trial basic and will be rescinded by the board of directors if they feel this is being abused. This is decremental to maintaining the area around the pool for the protection of the health and safety of the users.

(I)Regular pool hours are from Dawn to 9 PM. Visitors under sixteen (16) years of age are permitted to use the pool when accompanied by an adult.

17. PETS:

(c) Anyone visiting in the non-pet section is prohibited from being accompanied by any pet. Revised 4/15/2022

PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS PASSED MARCH 2020

8. PARKING

3. Remove the following verbiage — "Residents coming into the park after these rule changes take effect will not be allowed to park this type of vehicle anywhere in the park except on their own drive. For residents that were resident/owners prior to the effective date of these rule changes."

- b. Remove Paragraph 3-part b. "Any new owner/resident taking possession after the effective date of this rule change will not be offered the opportunity to park these types of vehicles in the park."
- h. The size limitation for trailers, boats, boat trailers; parked in the eight (8) allocated designated parking places at the south end of the park will be limited to 8' X 27' with a weight limit of 10,000 lbs.

j. Remove paragraph 3-part j. Upon approval of these rules a grace period until Oct 1, 2020 is offered for persons presently parked here. In the event no space is available for vehicles currently parked (e.g. the resident has more than one vehicle parked) the vehicle(s) in question will have to be removed from the park or placed on the residents' driveway.
